Manager's Introduction

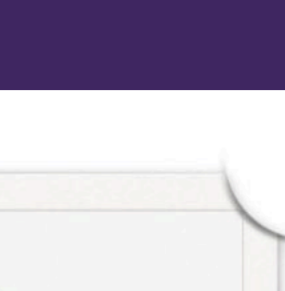

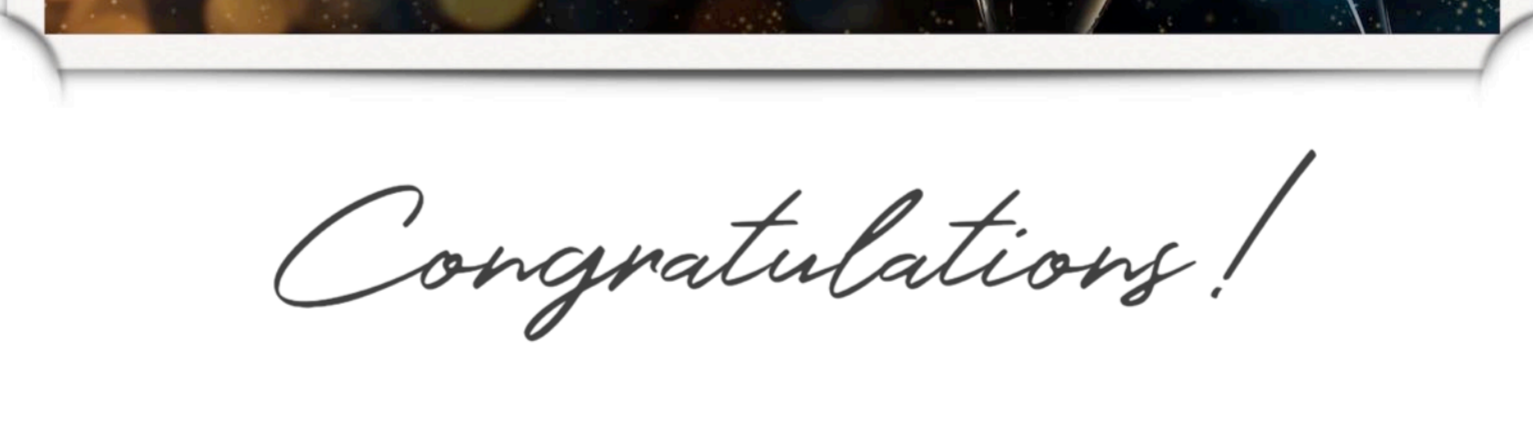


Spiritual Wellbeing

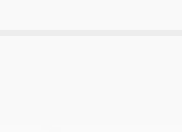
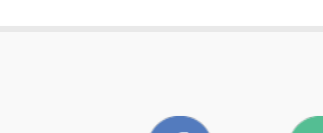
